Admission Guidelines

Examination for transfer students, 2024

Educational objectives

First, we further promote students' character education based on the spirit of Christian and provide character education that willingly serves God and others.

Second, we will organize classes that consist of not only Japanese students but also of increasing number of non-Japanese students. Then we cultivate international citizens who can understand diverse cultures and respect diversity.

Third, we develop human resources who can commit to contributing to a global society and have a spirit of inquiry, knowledge, the ability to think logically, and transmit information. We also develop students who keep on challenging difficulties.

Fourth, we will organize small-sized classes in which the independence of each student is respected and foster a positive attitude for working on difficult tasks.

Three policies

Diploma Policy "What should students acquire upon graduation?"

- 1. Children will have an increased sense of curiosity and self-awareness, and be inclined to explore and embrace challenges.
- 2. Children will cultivate a sense of gratitude towards others and gain a proactive sense of service toward their surroundings in order to build a better society.
- 3. Children will gain a respect for diversity of various cultures and languages, also have excellent communication skills and global leadership.

Curriculum Policy

- 1. The educational program looks to foster curiosity, exploration, and in-depth learning about problem solving.
- 2. The bilingual education program aims to develop the ability to understand others' way of thinking and convey one's own thoughts confidently in both English and Japanese.
- 3. The educational program aims to instill respect for cultural and linguistic diversity, as well as develops global leadership.
- 4. The educational program aims to cultivate the necessary ICT skills for gathering information in the fast-paced digital age, while also promoting a balanced understanding of information literacy.

Admission Policy "What are our admission expectations for students?"

- 1. Children who can take responsibility for their actions and act with consideration and appreciation towards others.
- 2. Children who have curiosity and a willingness to learn collaboratively with others.
- 3. Families are expected to understand the educational policies of the school and collaborate with the school to support their children's growth.

Examination for transfer students, 2024

1. Eligibility Criteria for Application

Our school is recruiting transfer students who meet the following application criteria:

- (1) Applicants who show understanding of the ethics of Christian education at the school.
- (2) Applicants who agree with the school's educational objectives and three policies.
- (3) The grades for which applicants may apply are as follows.
 - i .First-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2017, and April 1, 2018.
 - $\rm ii$.Second-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2016, and April 1, 2017.
 - iii. Third-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2015, and April 1, 2016.
 - iv . Fourth-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2014 and April 1, 2015.
 - v .Fifth-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2013 and April 1, 2014.
 - vi .Sixth-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2012 and April 1, 2013.

2. Enrollment Capacity

- Students from first grade to fourth grade will be recruited.
- For the two new grades 5 and 6, double classes may be established and opened depending on the number of students enrolled.
- Twenty students will be accepted per grade level.
 - * Capacity includes currently enrolled students.

3. Admission Schedule

- Admissions for transfer students will be conducted monthly.
- Please ask about the entrance examination schedule.
- Our schools may offer online admissions for applicants from abroad.

4. Application Method

- Please apply via our internet application system (F-REGI) on the school's website at https://ps.kluther-gakuin.jp/.
- Entrance examination fee: 10,000 JPY
- Once paid, the entrance examination fee is non-refundable.

5. Entrance Examination

- (1) The interviews will be conducted in both Japanese and English, but questions and answers directed towards Japanese parents will be in Japanese.
- (2) Transfer students will take a listening and oral test in English that corresponds to their ageappropriate level.

6. Notification of Acceptance

- The result will be posted on the International School, Primary School Division's website at https://ps.kluther-gakuin.jp/ for a certain period of time from the date of the announcement.
- · We are unable to provide information regarding the result via phone inquiries or other means.

7. Enrollment Procedures

Notification of acceptance and the necessary documents for enrollment will be sent.

- (1) Registration fee: 300,000 JPY
- (2) Deadline for enrollment and registration fee payment will be stated in the documents.
 - *If the enrollment procedures are not completed by the payment deadline, it will be considered as declining enrollment.
 - (In the event that there is an alternate applicant, the alternate applicant may be moved up in rank.)
- (3) Payment method: Bank transfer

8. Tuition and Fees

(1) Tuition fee (annually) 950,000 JPY *


(2) Educational enhancement fee (annually) 100,000 JPY


