Admission Guidelines for the School Year of 2024-2025

<October 2023 Revised>

Educational objectives

First, we further promote students' character education based on the spirit of Christian and provide character education that willingly serves God and others.

Second, we will organize classes that consist of not only Japanese students but also of increasing number of non-Japanese students. Then we cultivate international citizens who can understand diverse cultures and respect diversity.

Third, we develop human resources who can commit to contributing to a global society and have a spirit of inquiry, knowledge, the ability to think logically, and transmit information. We also develop students who keep on challenging difficulties.

Fourth, we will organize small-sized classes in which the independence of each student is respected and foster a positive attitude for working on difficult tasks.

Three policies

Diploma Policy "What should students acquire upon graduation?"

- 1. Children will have an increased sense of curiosity and self-awareness, and be inclined to explore and embrace challenges.
- 2.Children will cultivate a sense of gratitude towards others and gain a proactive sense of service toward their surroundings in order to build a better society.
- 3. Children will gain a respect for diversity of various cultures and languages, also have excellent communication skills and global leadership.

Curriculum Policy

- 1. The educational program looks to foster curiosity, exploration, and in-depth learning about problem solving.
- 2. The bilingual education program aims to develop the ability to understand others' way of thinking and convey one's own thoughts confidently in both English and Japanese.
- 3. The educational program aims to instill respect for cultural and linguistic diversity, as well as develops global leadership.
- 4.The educational program aims to cultivate the necessary ICT skills for gathering information in the fast-paced digital age, while also promoting a balanced understanding of information literacy.

Admission Policy "What are our admission expectations for students?"

- 1. Children who can take responsibility for their actions and act with consideration and appreciation towards others.
- 2. Children who have curiosity and a willingness to learn collaboratively with others.
- 3. Families are expected to understand the educational policies of the school and collaborate with the school to support their children's growth.

Admission Guidelines for the School Year of 2024-2025

1. Eligibility Criteria for Application

The school is recruiting applicants for the 2024 school year who meet the following application criterion.

- (1) Applicants who show understanding of the ethics of Christian education at the school.
- (2) Applicants who agree with the school's educational objectives and three policies.
- (3) The grades for which applicants may apply are as follows.
 - (i) First-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2017, and April 1, 2018.
 - (ii) Second-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2016, and April 1, 2017, be enrolled in primary grade 1 at the time of application and wish to transfer to the second grade in April 2024.
 - (iii) Third-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2015, and April 1, 2016, be enrolled in primary grade 2 at the time of application and wish to transfer to the third grade in April 2024.
 - (iv) Fourth-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2014 and April 1, 2015, be enrolled in primary grade 3 at the time of application and wish to transfer to the fourth grade in April 2024.
 - (v) Fifth-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2013 and April 1, 2014, be enrolled in primary grade 4 at the time of application and wish to transfer to the fifth grade in April 2024.
 - (vi) Sixth-grade students must have been born between April 2, 2012 and April 1, 2013, be enrolled in primary grade 5 at the time of application and wish to transfer to the sixth grade in April 2024.

2. Enrollment Capacity

Students from first grade to fourth grade will be recruited.

For the two new grades 5 and 6, double classes may be established and opened depending on the number of students enrolled.

3. Twenty students will be accepted per grade level.

*Admission quotas will be established for foreign nationals in each grade, with a total of 20 foreign students being admitted across six grades.

(The quota for foreign nations includes individuals with dual citizenship and excludes Japanese children returning to Japan.)

* If you are enrolled in a primary school overseas, the grade in which you will be enrolled will be discussed after your application is accepted.

 - The reception and examination times will be stated on the examination vouchers.
 - The applicant and 1 or 2 guardians will be administered the entrance examination.

- (3) For transfer students, an English proficiency test will be conducted, including a listening, oral, and academic ability test such as numerical comprehension text in English that corresponds to their age-appropriate level.
